“Surely the LORD is in this place, and I wasn’t even aware of it!” ...

Genesis 28:16 NLT

These were the words of Jacob who had an amazing encounter with God. He was about to enter a “new season”. This man had left Beersheba, an Oasis in the Negev Desert (Gen 28:10) which tells us that he was leaving the “old season” behind. He came to a place called Haran, which means “crossroads”. Crossroads are a place where two paths cross, but the right one must be chosen to reach the right destination. As you leave the “old season” behind, the choices you make will impact how you enter the “new season”. Jacob was able to begin his journey after this crossroad encounter with God. **This encounter helped Jacob enter his “new season”**. Why? In this encounter Jacob heard about God’s provision for the “new season” and the journey He was to undertake. In this encounter, he had a revelation of God’s love; a promise that God would be with him and provide for him; and a promise that God would give him a future. If we want to enter the “new season” we need to have an encounter with Jesus Christ by the revelation that comes from the Holy Spirit. We need to know that God loves us, that He provides for us and knows the future when all else is uncertain. Ask the Holy Spirit for this!

THE GLOBAL BODY OF CHRIST: Bride of Christ / The Church / Sacred Assembly / Fellowship of the Saints.

This is not the religious “Christian” institutions that we refer to. The Global Body of Christ is the fellowship of believers linked by being Born of God’s Spirit through faith in Jesus Christ. These believers are found all over the round, some have gone public and many work in secret. They are in denominations and Churches of all kinds bearing witness to the greatness of King Jesus. They are in the world but are not of it... These are who we pray for today... Please pray that:

1. God will keep shaking the Church so that the chaff and dross would be exposed in our lives. That God would purify His bride.
2. The Bride would overcome at this time by washing her garments in the blood of the lamb (Jesus), by declaring her testimony and not loving her life till death.
3. The Body of Christ would be filled by the Holy Spirit. May the bride overflow with living water. Pray that the Gifts of the Spirit all be active and flourishing in anointing and power. Pray for clear discernment and hearing from God.
4. The Body of Christ would grow in Prayer, Fellowship, Communion, Evangelism and Apostles teaching.
5. The Brides activities on the earth be a catalyst for the Holy Spirit to use in bringing in the end-time harvest.
6. The Bride will not fear persecution nor hurt; may she be resilient by the great grace and power of God.
