James 5:16 NLT

The word earnest means serious and deep. Righteous means “right doing”. If you are going to triumph in the “new season”, you are going to need serious prayers to accompany you on the journey; and these prayers will need to be made by a heart and life empowered by the right doing power of Christ. Prayer for some can be casual. We ask God for help or favour at times without taking His plan and vision for our future seriously. Serious prayers are prayers that reveal the determination that is your heart for the needs at hand. Others also say their prayers hit a wall. The wall is not in place because of God. The wall has been revealed by the Holy Spirit to you. Your heart has built a wall to keep God out. Hebrews 3:13 says that sin is deceitful and it hardens the heart. Repentance and turning towards God will soften your heart and collapse the walls. It is a simple matter of receiving the fellowship of Jesus by faith in your heart and His power for right doing becomes yours. Great power & wonderful results are waiting to accompany you in the “new season” the key to unlocking it, is serious prayer and Christ’s righteousness. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you pray serious prayers. Repent and welcome Jesus in if your heart has hardened toward Him.
