We live by believing and not by seeing.

2 Corinthians 5:7 NLT

Faith encourages the working of the supernatural power of God in our lives. Faith is essential for us to be born again: Jesus says “Even those who believe on my name shall be saved”. To enter a new season, faith must be allowed to work within us. As we walk by faith our eyes open to the spiritual realm, even though matters in the earthly realm seem impossible. Faith opens the spiritual eyes to see and it builds confidence so we can trust God’s whole perspective. This is so very different from the fragmented reality that earthly vision offers.

Many place a strong emphasis on material evidence before they believe Jesus. The apostle's Peter and Thomas – were moved by the miraculous works of Jesus. Peter saw Jesus Transfigured – he would be the same man who would deny Him three times. Thomas refused to accept the risen Christ – until He would appear before him so that he can place his fingers in His wounds. Jesus made it clear for all: “Blessed are those who believe and have not seen”. Pray for an anointing of God’s faith to launch you into the season God wants to open for you.
