*“My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?
Why are you so far away when I groan for
help?”*

Psalm 22:1 NLT

There are some Christians who do their best to avoid the “new season” if they feel that this season will be a lonely one. It is true that some seasons are “lonely ones”. David prophetically wrote Psalm 22:1 about the coming Messiah, Jesus Christ. Jesus cried to His Father while dying and suffering on His own. Jesus did this so we would never be alone. He took the lonely road so we could have His help during our “lonely seasons”. God promises us that He will never abandon us. He does so in Deuteronomy 31:6 & 8, Isaiah 41:10 and Hebrews 13:5. Jesus Christ also promised us that as we do the work of the Kingdom, then He will also be with us to the end of the world (see Matthew 28:20). There are lonely seasons but God will help us through them and accompany us. David tells us in Psalm 23 that He will not fear because the rod and staff of the Great shepherd is with him in the Valley of the Shadow of death. Even seasons where we walk the lonely road of illness and death, God assures us He is there to guide us through them. Ask the Holy Spirit to accompany you on the “new season” you are about to enter. Don’t be afraid to progress in the “new season” because of perceived loneliness.
