## *“Never stop praying.”*

1 Thessalonians 5:17 NLT

You may not know how to deal with issues facing you. The challenges may be few or many – but whatever you do NEVER stop praying. This is the best advice you will receive before and through each “new season”. The Apostle James says *“you don’t have what you want because you don’t ask God for it. And even when you ask, you don’t get it because your motives are all wrong”* James 4:2b-3a NLT. Most times people struggle with the following:

1. They never prayer – it doesn’t cross their mind or they don’t believe it helps
2. If they do pray they just pray whatever comes to mind that will solve the crisis or they ask for that which is not good for them.

The disciples of Jesus were never pretentious for a moment, they understood that effective prayer was lacking in their lives and they asked Jesus to teach them how to pray (See Luke 11:1). Consider the following:

- If you have a need come boldly with faith, never doubting God (Hebrews 4:16; James 1:5 – 8; Hebrews 11:6)
- Keep asking, seeking & knocking (Matthew 7:7-11) with meaningful prayer, not with repetitive/mindless chants (Matthew 6:7 - 8).
- Pray in your Spirit language, even if unsure of God’s will (Romans 8:26-28; Jude 1:20; 2 Timothy 1:6) this will lead you forward.

*“Go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.” Matthew 28:19 NLT.*

- We asked for God to bless us with the nations. We now also ask God to help us to disciple the nations once they receive His gift of salvation.
  - Pray that God would raise all believers to obey the command of Christ to disciple those they share the Gospel of the Kingdom with.
  - Pray that believers would understand the principles of multiplication, so that God’s people will be disciplined exponentially.
  - Pray that Home Churches would form as the Holy Spirit brings disciples together.
