*Wait patiently for the LORD.  
Be brave and courageous.  
Yes, wait patiently for the LORD.*

Psalm 27:14 NLT

As with any planting season, there is a transition period. Precious little can be done by a farmer until weather conditions turn favourably for planting and harvesting. Likewise, as we prepare to enter a “new season” we also have to wait. Waiting is difficult for us because the human species is a “time-aware” species. We know our time is short while on earth and we feel that if there are delays in the plans that God has for us that we will lose out in some way. It may happen that the enemy may also sow deception, fear and uncertainty, pushing us toward hasty choices. Add to this a shortage of patience and we could reap a painful harvest instead of one of blessing. God is also “Time-Aware”... unlike people, He prefers to concern Himself from this perspective....

EVERYTHING HAS PERFECT TIMING – HIS TIMING. If we trust Him then all things will happen in His perfect time. That is why Psalms encourages us to wait patiently on the Lord. Pray that the Holy Spirit will help us shift from being “Time-Aware” but **patient** and **obedient** to God.

# FAMILIES

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Today we are praying for FAMILIES:

1. Godly families are beautiful. To be part of a healthy family is a gift from God. Pray for families that are doing well, that God would keep those relationships safe and secure. Pray that the family unit will demonstrate the unity that is between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Pray for fathers to rise-up as the affirming voice in families.
2. Pray for struggling and/or broken family relationships. Pray that God would reconcile families. Pray that hearts and lives be brought back together so they can fulfil God's purpose on earth. Pray the Holy Spirit will convict of sin, righteousness and judgement.
3. Families are targeted by Satan to destroy society – as families form an important foundational role in the life of society. Pray that families will see the real picture, their enemies are not flesh and blood but the powers of darkness.
4. Rebellion, insecurity and selfishness can often split families in half. Pray that love, support and willingness to “hear one another” will be encouraged in families.
5. Families come in all shapes and sizes – many are not perfect but God has placed people in various families because that is where He feels they need to be and where they will be sharpened (iron sharpens iron) Pray that people will have the courage and determination to stick it through with their families when things are tough...
6. Reconciliation is an important work for a family to experience. Pray that families will grow more and more toward reconciliation.
