OVERCOME - INTRODUCTION

This is an important theme of the Old and New Testament.

Salvation by the blood of the Lamb and the forgiveness of sins paved the way forward for every child of God to live as an OVERCOMER!

While redemption and forgiveness remain essential themes, “overcoming” is God’s purpose for us. We do not remain at Calvary, but we need to move beyond Calvary as Jesus did. Jesus overcame the grave, temptation and hostile enemies. He rose again as our Christ and is seated victoriously on the right hand of the Father – His enemies crushed.

We are learning to follow this pattern, with the Holy Spirit’s help – we must die to self, arise with Christ in new life – and become overcomers.

This prayer guide for April is purposed to encourage Children of the Lord to step into the role of overcomer...

OVERCOME - WEEK 1 - DAY 1

“Do not let yourself be overcome by evil, but overcome (master) evil with good”.

Romans 12:21 AMP

With God, there can be no middle ground when it comes to the battle between good and evil. If we are not overcoming evil then we are being overcome by the powers of darkness and the evil they spread in the world.

Overcoming is not something we can take lightly, it is a strategic fight of life and death! Whether we want to be a willing participant or not... the fight is coming your way.

Dear Father, Establish us as overcomers of Evil in Jesus name. Amen

PRAYER – FRONTLINE WORKERS

Let's give thanks to God for the frontline workers who have laid their lives down in the line of duty. The Coronavirus pandemic has taken its toll on many medical, emergency and safety personnel who have placed themselves at great risk for us all.

Praise God for these men and women faithful to their calling!

OVERCOME - WEEK 1 - DAY 2

“Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live! You can make this choice by loving the Lord your God, obeying him, and committing yourself firmly to him. This is the key to your life. And if you love and obey the Lord, you will live long in the land...”

Deuteronomy 30:19-20 NLT

Some Christians give up on life when they are faced with challenges. Granted, the challenges may feel overwhelming. But those who want to overcome must choose life every time. To be victorious we must live victoriously – it is done by loving God, obeying Him and committing yourself to Him today. He will not fail you. He is faithful to His commitment to us.

OVERCOME - WEEK 1 - DAY 3

“Everything that has been fathered by God overcomes the corrupt world. This is the victory that has conquered the world: our faith (in God)”.

1 John 5:4 VOICE

If God is not our Father and if our faith is not placed in the salvation work of His son, Jesus. We can never become the overcomers that God envisions. To overcome is the natural work that will follow when we receive His salvation.

Dear Father, We receive your salvation through the finished work of Jesus on the cross. He showed us the meaning of overcoming. Thank you for dying for our sins and giving us the power to live lives that overcome. In Jesus name Amen.

PRAYER – EASTER / PASSOVER part 2

Pray for a world-wide move of the Holy Spirit to convict of sin, righteousness and judgement.

Pray that this starts with the Church – may God shake the Church, for this is where judgement must begin.

OVERCOME - WEEK 1 - DAY 4

“The angel told me to give Zerubbabel this message from the Lord: You will succeed, not by military might or by your own strength, but by my spirit.”

Zechariah 4:6 GNT

To overcome requires supernatural strength. The Lord tells Zerubbabel, to restore the walls of Jerusalem and the Temple would be a difficult task. The city had been ruined and the nation scattered. There would be much to prevent the completion of this monumental task. YET – God’s answer to Zerubbabel was simple... Not by might or by power but by my Spirit.

To overcome we require supernatural help and intervention that comes from the Holy Spirit!

Dear Father, we need your Holy Spirit to empower us to overcome. In Jesus name. Amen

PRAYER – OPEN DOORS, OPEN HEARTS, OPEN LIVES

We need open opportunities to reach the lives of people within our families, communities, cities and in the nations. Pray for these opportunities to manifest so Christians can engage others with the Gospel of the Kingdom of God.

OVERCOME - WEEK 1 - DAY 5

“In him was life, and that life was the light of men. That light shines in the darkness, and yet the darkness did not overcome it”.

John 1:4-5 CSB

The world will try to convince through its propaganda that the power of God is withering or weak or unnecessary for modern lives. The life that Jesus brings into our whole being is powerful indeed and it lights up the dead and the hidden things of darkness – overcoming it a million times over. BELIEVE that God is all-powerful so that you can see the power of His life and light working in & through you!

Dear Father, the world's propaganda machine is real. The spirits of doubt and confusion have always been at hand to challenge us and question the power of God. Today, we believe, You are who You say You are! Please establish this truth in our hearts. In Jesus name, Amen.

PRAYER – PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED

We are instructed to pray for the persecuted Church. Brothers and sisters around the world, who experience extra-ordinary challenges, trials and persecution by the hand of those who reject Jesus. Pray that the persecuted will lovingly shine their light brighter and brighter by the help of the Holy Spirit.



OVERCOME - WEEK 1 - DAY 6

“You crown the year with Your goodness, And Your paths drip with abundance.”

Psalm 65: 11 NKJV

The year that the Corononavirus pandemic hit... so many lost their hope in the turmoil that followed. Overcomers are those whose hope is set on the Lord. For He is true to His Word! Despite all that has happened, believers from around the world have testified of overcoming their challenges. Their testimony was that GOD was the author of their lives, not the powers that be... and it is the Lord who will crown their year with goodness not the corona (crown) virus. You’ve crowned me with love and mercy. You satisfy my every desire with good things. You’ve supercharged my life so that I soar again like a flying eagle in the sky!”
